**A RESOLUTION TO REDUCE THE SPEED LIMIT ON PLEASANT VIEW ROAD  
FROM 25 MPH TO 20 MPH**

**Resolved that,**

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council that conditions exist on Pleasant View Road, a residential district, that warrant reducing the speed limit from 25 MPH to 20 MPH; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to R.I.G.L. § 31-14-5, local authorities may reduce the prima facie speed limit of 25 MPH on local streets within a business or residence district upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation finding such speed is greater than reasonable or safe, and upon the erection of appropriate signs giving notice of the reduced speed limit; and

WHEREAS, a traffic survey was conducted by the Police Department which recommended that the aforementioned reduction in speed limit be implemented; and

WHEREAS, an engineering study was conducted by the City Engineer which recommended that the aforementioned reduction in speed limit be implemented; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by virtue of the authority of Chapter 76 Article I Section 76-13 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warwick, may determine that certain traffic signs are required for the protection of the public safety.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Warwick City Council, pursuant to R.I.G.L. § 31-14-5, hereby reduces the speed limit on Pleasant View Road from 25 MPH to 20 MPH; and
