RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN EXTENSION OF WEST PONTIAC STREET
AS A CITY STREET

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Rhode Island General Laws 24-2-1 provides that the City Council may declare land that has been used and improved and considered as a public highway for a period of 20 years as a City public highway; and

WHEREAS, a roadway that runs from Pontiac Street northwesterly to the parking lot for the playground as shown and marked on the image attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the roadway is a portion of West Pontiac Street; and

WHEREAS, the roadway has been used, improved and considered as a public highway for a period of 20 years; and

WHEREAS, declaring the roadway as a portion of West Pontiac Street will allow residences on the roadway to connect separate water lines to the residences.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Warwick City Council hereby declares the roadway marked on the exhibit attached hereto as a City public highway and is a portion of West Pontiac Street.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Directors of all the Departments in the City, the Kent County Water Authority and the Warwick Sewer Authority.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
