RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO PLACING A STOP SIGN ON BAYSIDE AVENUE AT
THE INTERSECTION OF NARRAGANSETT PARKWAY

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council that a dangerous situation exists at the intersection of Bayside Drive and Narragansett Parkway; and

WHEREAS, a traffic survey was conducted by the Police Department which recommended that a stop sign be placed on Bayside Drive to control the traffic traveling westbound and entering the intersection with Narragansett Parkway; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by virtue of the authority of Chapter 76 Article 1 Section 76-13 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warwick, may determine that certain traffic signs are required for the protection of the public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Director of Public Works is hereby directed to place a stop sign on Bayside Drive to control the traffic traveling westbound and entering the intersection with Narragansett Parkway.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of Public Works and the Chief of the Police Department.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.

1 Traffic Survey

2017-24

I Officer Curley, was assigned this traffic study in regards to placing a stop sign on Bayside Avenue at Narragansett Parkway. Bayside Avenue is a split street that is divided by the two lanes of travel on Narragansett Parkway. Bayside Avenue runs both eastbound and westbound. On the portion of Bayside Avenue that runs eastbound towards the water there is already a stop sign placed at the corner forcing traffic to stop prior to advancing onto Narragansett Parkway.

This area has a relatively high level of foot traffic from pedestrians and adding a stop sign at this location would provide additional safety to those pedestrians crossing this portion of the roadway. It should also be noted a large majority of the side streets leading onto Narragansett Parkway are controlled by the placement of Stop Signs. After viewing the roadway at this location and consulting the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices it is my recommendation that this request be granted and a stop sign be placed on the westbound side of Bayside Avenue.
