**RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO PLACING STOP SIGNS ON LYMAN AVENUE AT  
THE INTERSECTION OF BUDLONG AVENUE**

**Resolved that,**

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council that a dangerous situation exists at the intersection of Lyman Avenue and Budlong Avenue; and

WHEREAS, a traffic survey was conducted by the Police Department which recommended that stop signs be placed on Lyman Avenue at the intersection of Budlong Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by virtue of the authority of Chapter 76 Article 1 Section 76-13 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warwick, may determine that certain traffic signs are required for the protection of the public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Director of Public Works is hereby directed to place stop signs on Lyman Avenue at the intersection of Budlong Avenue.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of Public Works and the Chief of the Police Department.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
