RESOLUTION REGARDING ERECTING A STOP SIGN
AT THE INTERSECTION OF MARBLEHEAD STREET AND HOLDEN STREET

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, several residents of Marblehead Street and Holden Street have expressed concern about vehicles speeding on these streets during the summer months, due to the proximity to Bay and Wharf Marinas;

WHEREAS, a traffic study was conducted in January 2020 wherein it was recommended that a stop sign be erected at the most easterly end of Marblehead Street where it meets Holden Street;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council hereby requests that a stop sign be erected in the area as described herein.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Department of Public Works, the Finance Director and the Mayor.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
