**RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS
ADDRESS THE POT HOLES, SINK HOLES AND DRAINAGE ISSUES
AT THE ANGLESEA COMMUNITY**

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the Anglesea Neighborhood is situated in the Warwick Neck area of the City of Warwick;

WHEREAS, the Anglesea Neighborhood spans over the Main Channel, Port Circle and Channel View roads;

WHEREAS; residents on these roads have been experiencing issues with pot holes, sink holes, and depressions in the street, which make the roads difficult to traverse;

WHEREAS, there is also a stain on Channel View, approximately one-hundred feet (100') in length, caused by a hydraulic leak from a City vehicle this past summer, that has not been addressed;

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works and the Mayor visited the Anglesea Neighborhood on or around May 2019 and saw most of the aforementioned issues first-hand;

WHEREAS, several maintenance requests have been made to the Director of the Department of Public Works and the Mayor, but have not been addressed or remedied by the Department;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council hereby requests that the Department of Public Works promptly address the pot holes, sink holes, and depressions, as well as the staining in the Anglesea Neighborhood.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Department of Public Works, the Finance Director and the Mayor.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
