**RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE CITY ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT
MAKE QUARTERLY APPEARANCES BEFORE THE CITY COUNCIL
TO REPORT ON STORMWATER RELATED PERMIT ISSUES**

2 **Resolved that,**

4 WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are
5 matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

6 WHEREAS, the City has a RI Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (“RIPDES”)
7 permit; and

9 WHEREAS, this is the backbone of the state's water pollution control strategy, which
10 includes developing & enforcing permit limitations for municipal and industrial wastewaters,
11 storm water, & combined sewer overflows discharged directly to the waters of the state, as well
12 as industrial wastewaters discharged to municipally-owned treatment facilities; and

14 WHEREAS, it is extremely important for the City to maintain compliance with its
15 RIPDES permit; and

16
17 WHEREAS, compliance with the permit requirements, maintaining adequate funding for
18 compliance and monitoring expenditures made in furtherance of compliance are matters of great
19 importance to the City Council.

21 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Warwick City Council hereby requests
22 that a representative of the City Engineering Division appear quarterly before the City Council
23 commencing with the first City Council meeting in March to provide a report to the City Council
24 on the City’s progress in maintaining compliance with its RIPDES permit and the status of
25 expenditures versus available funding for maintenance of compliance with the RIPDES permit.

27 The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the City
28 Engineering Division and the Director of Public Works.

30 This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
