**RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS
ADDRESS TREE DEBRIS AND STREET FLOODING IN THE VICINITY
OF HAMPTON AND GRAY STREETS**

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, residents on Hampton Street and Gray Street in Warwick, Rhode Island, have been experiencing issues with tree debris and street flooding from a storm that causes concern for their health and safety; and

WHEREAS, said flooding is in the vicinity of Pole #7 at the intersection of Hampton and Gray Street;

WHEREAS, there is a downed tree opposite Pole #31 on Hampton Street;

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works visited Hampton and Gray Streets in or around May 2019 and saw the debris and flooding first-hand;

WHEREAS, several maintenance requests have been made to the Director of the Department of Public Works, but the tree debris and flooding remain a persistent problem and have not been addressed;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council hereby requests that the Department of Public Works promptly address the tree debris and the street flooding on Hampton Street and Gray Street.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Department of Public Works, the Finance Director and the Mayor.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
