**RESOLUTION IN REGARDS TO ERECTING A STOP SIGN
AT THE NORTHEAST INTERSECTION OF ABBOT AVENUE
AND CLINTON AVENUE**

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, a resident raised concerns regarding the heightened speed at which drivers operate their vehicles when traveling on Abbot Avenue; and

WHEREAS, a traffic study was conducted by the Warwick Police Department on February 7, 2020 wherein said resident’s concerns were verified and it was recommended that a stop sign be places at the northeast intersection of Abbot Avenue and Clinton Avenue in order to slow vehicles traveling north on Abbot Avenue.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council hereby requests that a stop sign be erected at the northeastern intersection of Abbot Avenue and Clinton Avenue.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Department of Public Works, the Finance Director and the Mayor.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
