**A RESOLUTION IN REGARDS TO AUTHORIZING AND REPOSITIONING THE
STOP SIGN ON GLENCO ROAD WHERE IT INTERSECTS WITH WHARF ROAD**

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council that dangerous situations exist at the intersection of Glenco Road and Wharf Road; and

WHEREAS, a traffic survey was conducted by Officer Thomas Greene of the Warwick Police Department which recommended that the existing stop sign on Glenco Road where it intersects with Wharf Road be formally authorized and moved closer to the actual intersection at Wharf Road; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by virtue of the authority of Chapter 76, Article 1, Section 76-13 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warwick, may determine that certain traffic signs are required for the protection of the public safety.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the stop sign on Glenco Road where it intersects with Wharf Road is hereby authorized and the Director of Public Works is hereby directed to move the stop sign closer to the actual intersection at Wharf Road.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Department of Public Works and the Chief of the Police Department.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
