<b>RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE 375<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY COMMISSION FOR THE CITY OF WARWICK</b>
<b>RESOLVED</b> , that
WHEREAS: it has been brought to the attention of the City Council of the City of Warwick that there exists a need for the creation of a sixteen (16) member commission called the Warwick 375th Anniversary Commission to plan and execute fitting community celebrations in honor of the 375 <sup>th</sup> anniversary of the founding of the City of Warwick; and
WHEREAS: THE City Council of the City of Warwick acknowledges and supports the efforts to educate, celebrate and commemorate the founding of the community; and
<b>WHEREAS</b> : this initiative is compatible with our community's interests and goals related to historic preservation; and
<b>WHEREAS</b> : commemoration of this event will improve our community's ability to protect and promote its historical resources.
<b>NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,</b> that the City Council of the City of Warwick hereby authorizes the establishment of a sixteen (16) member 375 <sup>th</sup> Anniversary Commission, which shall be appointed, as follows:
1. Four (4) members appointed by the Mayor, including the Chairman of the Commission;
2. One (1) member appointed by each member of the City Council, for a total of nine (9) appointments;
3. One (1) member appointed by the President of the Warwick Historical Society;
4. One (1) member appointed by the President of the Gaspee Day Committee; and
5. One (1) member appointed by the School Committee of the City of Warwick.

2 The City Council of the City of Warwick further authorizes the Mayor of the City of 3 Warwick to take such other and further actions as may be necessary to fully effect this 4 authorization of the Warwick City Council; and 5

6 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Mayor and the Warwick City Council agree to 7 protect and celebrate our heritage, use our historic assets for economic development and 8 community revitalization, and encourage people to experience and appreciate local historic 9 resources through education and heritage tourism programs.
