RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE
375TH ANNIVERSARY COMMISSION FOR THE CITY OF WARWICK

RESOLVED, that

WHEREAS: it has been brought to the attention of the City Council of the City of Warwick that there exists a need for the creation of a sixteen (16) member commission called the Warwick 375th Anniversary Commission to plan and execute fitting community celebrations in honor of the 375th anniversary of the founding of the City of Warwick; and

WHEREAS: THE City Council of the City of Warwick acknowledges and supports the efforts to educate, celebrate and commemorate the founding of the community; and

WHEREAS: this initiative is compatible with our community's interests and goals related to historic preservation; and

WHEREAS: commemoration of this event will improve our community's ability to protect and promote its historical resources.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Warwick hereby authorizes the establishment of a sixteen (16) member 375th Anniversary Commission, which shall be appointed, as follows:

1. Four (4) members appointed by the Mayor, including the Chairman of the Commission;
2. One (1) member appointed by each member of the City Council, for a total of nine (9) appointments;
3. One (1) member appointed by the President of the Warwick Historical Society;
4. One (1) member appointed by the President of the Gaspee Day Committee; and
5. One (1) member appointed by the School Committee of the City of Warwick.

The City Council of the City of Warwick further authorizes the Mayor of the City of Warwick to take such other and further actions as may be necessary to fully effect this authorization of the Warwick City Council; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and the Warwick City Council agree to protect and celebrate our heritage, use our historic assets for economic development and community revitalization, and encourage people to experience and appreciate local historic resources through education and heritage tourism programs.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
