RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO PLACING DO NOT ENTER SIGNS AT LIPPITT SCHOOL ON ALMY STREET AT THE FRONT PARKING LOT AND ON GULF STREET AT THE REAR PARKING LOT

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council that a very dangerous situation exists at the parking lots at Lippit School; and

WHEREAS, a traffic survey was conducted by the Police Department which recommended that "Do Not Enter 8:15 to 8:45 and 2:30 to 2:50" signs be erected on Almy Street at the front parking lot for the school and on Gulf Street at the rear parking lot for the school; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by virtue of the authority of Chapter 76 Article 1 Section 76-13 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warwick, may determine that certain traffic signs and signals are required for the protection of the public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of Public Works is hereby directed to erect "Do Not Enter 8:15 to 8:45 and 2:30 to 2:50" signs on Almy Street at the front parking lot for the school and on Gulf Street at the rear parking lot for the school.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of Public Works and the Chief of the Police Department.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
