RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE RESTORATION OF PUBLIC MOORINGS
AT GODDARD STATE PARK

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Rhode Island has called for improving recreation facilities at the State’s parks; and

WHEREAS, the Governor mentioned Goddard State Park in Warwick as a site where recreational facilities could be enhanced and improved; and

WHEREAS, there were at one time three or four moorings in front of Goddard State Park that boaters could use, but the moorings were removed some years ago; and

WHEREAS, the Warwick City Council desires to have the moorings reinstalled because it would attract boaters from around the State to Goddard State Park and the surrounding area; and

WHEREAS, the cost to reinstall the moorings is low compared to the benefit that would be generated for people who want to visit and utilize the facilities at Goddard State Park; and

WHEREAS, the moorings could be added to the Warwick Blueways Trails, which are paths on the water.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Warwick City Council hereby requests Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management reinstall moorings in front of Goddard State Park.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
