RESOLUTION IN REGARDS TO ERECTING A STOP SIGN ON MAYWOOD AVENUE TO STOP TRAFFIC FROM ENTERING ONTO BEACH AVENUE

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, a traffic study was conducted by the Warwick Police Department on March 4, 2020 of the intersection of Beach and Maywood Avenues; and

WHEREAS, the traffic study determined that the speed limit on both Beach Avenue and Maywood Avenue is 25 miles per hour (mph) and that Beach Avenue is considered a primary road, whereas Maywood Avenue is considered a secondary road; and

WHEREAS, the traffic study indicated that there had been no accidents reported at this intersection, but the recommendation was that a stop sign should be placed on Maywood Avenue to stop traffic entering onto Beach Avenue.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council hereby requests that a stop sign be installed in the area described herein.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Department of Public Works, the Finance Director, and the Mayor.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
