RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO SIGNS ON POTOWOMUT ROAD  
TO INCREASE THE SPEED LIMIT FROM 15 MPH TO 25 MPH

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council that conditions exist on Potowomut Road between the North Kingstown town lien and the intersection with Austin Road that warrant increasing the speed limit from the current 15 MPH to 25 MPH; and

WHEREAS, a traffic survey was conducted by the Police Department which recommended that the aforementioned increase in speed limit be implemented and that signs indicating that increase in speed limit be posted; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by virtue of the authority of Chapter 76 Article 1 Section 76-13 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warwick, may determine that traffic signs are required for the protection of the public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Director of Public Works is hereby directed to erect the speed limit signs on Potowomut Road between the North Kingstown town lien and the intersection with Austin Road that increase the posted speed limit from the current 15 MPH to 25 MPH.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of Public Works and the Chief of the Police Department.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
