17	WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are		
18	matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

20	WHEREAS, for many people, public libraries are their only means of access to books,		
21	computer services, technology training, and all forms of media essential for fulfilling and		
22	productive lives; and		
23			
24	WHEREAS, free public libraries are essential to the general enlightenment of citizens in		
25	democracy and provide for the cultural, educational, informational, and research needs of all		
26	citizens; and		
27			
28	WHEREAS, Article XII of the Constitution of the State of Rhode Island provides that it		
29	"shall be the duty of the General Assembly to promote public schools and public libraries, and to		
30 31	adopt all means which it deems necessary and proper to secure to the people the advantages and		
32	opportunities of education and public library services"; and		
33	WHEREAS, since FY2009 the State of Rhode Island has not funded state aid to libraries		
34	at the twenty-five percent (25%) of the amount spent from local tax funds and a library's private		
35	endowment as prescribed in RIGL §29-6-2; and		
36	endowment us presenteed in Riol 329 6 2, and		
37	WHEREAS, the Governor's proposed FY2023 budget funds state aid to libraries at 22.4%,		
38	which if enacted would result in \$76,400 less state aid to the City of Warwick than at the 25%		
39	level; and

41	WHEREAS, the Warwick City Council supports fully funding State Aid to Libraries at the		
42	25% level in FY2023.

44	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Warwick City Council hereby		
45	respectfully requests the Rhode Island General Assembly to restore funding for State Aid to		
46	Libraries at the twenty-five percent (25%) level prescribed in RIGL §29-6-2 in the FY2023 budget.
