A RESOLUTION IN REGARDS TO ERECTING STOP SIGNS ON MEADOW VIEW AVENUE WHERE IT INTERSECTS CLIFTON AVENUE AND ON PAINE STREET WHERE IT INTERSECTS CHATFIELD STREET

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council that dangerous situations exist at the intersections of Meadow View Avenue and Clifton Avenue, and at Paine Street and Chatfield Street; and

WHEREAS, a traffic survey was conducted by Officer Jacob Elderkin of the Warwick Police Department which recommended that stop signs be placed on Meadow View Avenue at the intersection of Clifton Avenue to stop traffic coming off of Meadow View Avenue, and on Paine Street where it intersects Chatfield Street to stop the traffic coming off of Paine Street; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by virtue of the authority of Chapter 76, Article 1, Section 76-13 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warwick, may determine that certain traffic signs are required for the protection of the public safety.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of Public Works is hereby directed to place a stop sign on Meadow View Avenue where it intersects Clifton Avenue to stop traffic coming off of Meadow View Avenue, and on Paine Street where it intersects Chatfield Street to stop traffic coming off of Paine Street.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Department of Public Works and the Chief of the Police Department.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
