**A RESOLUTION IN REGARDS TO REMOVING “NO PARKING EITHER SIDE”  
SIGNS ON HOPKINS AVENUE AND COLLINS AVENUE**

**Resolved that,**

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, a traffic survey was conducted by the Police Department which recommended the removal of the currently erected “No Parking Either Side” signs on Hopkins Avenue and Collins Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by virtue of the authority of Chapter 76 Article 1 Section 76-13 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warwick, may determine that certain traffic signs are required for the protection of the public safety; and

WHEREAS, the department of public works, by virtue of the authority of Chapter 76 Article 1 Section 76-14 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warwick, is responsible for the erection and maintenance of traffic signs.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of Public Works is hereby directed to remove the “No Parking Either Side” signs on Hopkins Avenue and Collins Avenue.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Department of Public Works and the Chief of the Police Department.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
