**RESOLUTION IN REGARDS TO ERECTING TWO STOP SIGNS: (1) WESTBOUND
AT THE INTERSECTION OF PLANTATION STREET AND VANCOUVER AVENUE
AND (2) EASTBOUND AT THE INTERSECTION OF NORTHBRIDGE AVENUE AND
VANCOUVER AVENUE**

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, a traffic study was conducted by the Warwick Police Department on various dates in June 2020 of the intersections of Plantation Street and Vancouver Avenue and Northbridge Avenue and Vancouver Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the traffic study indicated that these roads connect a small neighborhood to Greenwich Avenue, and that there are not presently stop signs located in the aforementioned areas; and

WHEREAS, the traffic study ultimately recommended that a stop sign be placed in a westbound direction on Plantation Street, at the intersection of Plantation Street and Vancouver Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the traffic study further recommended that a stop sign be placed in an eastbound direction on Northbridge Avenue, at the intersection of Northbridge Avenue and Vancouver Avenue.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council hereby requests that a stop sign be installed in the areas described herein.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Department of Public Works, the Finance Director, and the Mayor.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
