**RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE BUDGET AND SETTING THE TAX RATES OF THE
CITY OF WARWICK FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2022 AND
ENDING JUNE 30, 2023**

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget, as submitted by the Mayor of the City of Warwick for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023 as attached hereto and incorporated by reference, has been considered by the Council of the City of Warwick.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

SECTION I. That the Warwick City Council hereby approves and adopts the Annual Budget attached hereto.

SECTION II. The City Council of the City of Warwick does hereby order the assessment and collection of property tax on the ratable real estate and the tangible personal property and an excise tax on registered motor vehicles and trailers in a sum not to exceed \$234,000,000 in accordance with § 44-5-2 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island, as amended, said tax is for ordinary charges and reserves of said City and for other purposes authorized by law.

SECTION III. The City Assessor shall assess and apportion said tax on the inhabitants and ratable property of said City as of the 31st day of December, A.D. 2021 at 12:00 midnight Eastern Standard Time in accordance with § 44-5-1 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, as amended, and shall, on completion of said assessment, date, certify and sign the same and deliver to and deposit the same in the office of the Finance Director in accordance with § 44-5-22 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island, as amended. The Finance Director, on receipt of said assessment, shall forthwith make a copy of the same and deliver to the City Collector of said City commanding her to proceed and collect said tax on the persons and estate liable therefore. Said tax shall be due and payable on this fifteenth day of July, 2022 and all taxes remaining unpaid on the fifteenth day of September, 2022 shall carry until collected a penalty at the rate of one percent (1%) per month thereafter upon such unpaid tax from the fifteenth day of July, 2022. Said tax may be paid in quarterly installments, the first installment of twenty-five per centum (25%) on or before the fifteenth day of July, 2022, and the remaining installments as follows twenty-five per centum (25%) on or before the fifteenth day of October, 2022, twenty-five per centum (25%) on or before

1 the fifteenth day of January, 2023 and twenty-five per centum (25%) on or before the fifteenth day
2 of April, 2023. Each installment of taxes, if paid on or before the last day of each installment
3 period successively and in order, shall be free from any charge for interest. If the first installment
4 or any succeeding installment of taxes is not paid by the last day of the respective installment
5 period or periods as they occur, then the whole tax or remaining unpaid balance of the tax as the
6 case may be, shall immediately become due and payable with interest computed at the same rates
7 as are specified in this section computed from July 15, 2022.
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9 SECTION IV. It is estimated that the property tax revenues will result in a property tax
10 rate for class 1 property of \$18.73 per \$1,000 assessed valuation, a property tax rate for class 2
11 property of \$28.10 per \$1,000 assessed valuation, a property tax rate for class 3 property of \$37.46
12 per \$1,000 assessed valuation, and a property tax rate for class 4 property of \$20.00 per \$1,000
13 assessed valuation, or as otherwise provided under Rhode Island law. The Tax Assessor is hereby
14 authorized to set the final tax rates at the rates required to generate a tax levy up to the not to
15 exceed amount stated in Section II above for each and every class of property upon certification
16 of the Tax Roll and pursuant to the mandates of § 44-5-2 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode
17 Island, as amended. In accordance with § 44-5-2 (b) of the General Laws of the State of Rhode
18 Island, as amended, the tax rate qualifies for certification by the State of Rhode Island.
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20 SECTION V. The City Council of the City of Warwick also adopts the American Rescue
21 Plan budget as attached hereto as incorporated in the annual capital budget of the City, and such
22 budget shall apply and be available for encumbrance by the City of Warwick until December 31,
23 2024 with final expenditure by December 31, 2026 in accordance with the Final Rules (31 CFR
24 Part 35) applying to this Federal Act. Nothing herein shall prohibit the Mayor and City Council
25 from amending this budget plan before December 31, 2024.
