RESOLUTION IN REGARDS TO ERECTING A STOP SIGN ON POCAHONTAS
DRIVE AT THE INTERSECTION OF COLDBROOK ROAD

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, a traffic study was conducted by Officer Jason Brodeur of the Warwick Police Department at the intersection of Coldbrook Road and Pocahontas Drive in or around April 15, 2019; and

WHEREAS, within the traffic study, it was stated that Coldbrook Road is the primary street of that intersection, running through the main artery that is Namquid Drive, and that Pocahontas Road is the secondary road within said intersection; and

WHEREAS, the traffic study recommended that Pocahontas Drive receive stop signs at both the northerly and southernly points of the intersection with Coldbrook Road so that traffic on Pocahontas Drive would stop and yield to the primary flow of traffic on Coldbrook Road; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by virtue of the authority of Chapter 76, Article I, Section § 76-13 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Warwick, may determine that certain traffic signs are required for the protection of public safety.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of Public Works is hereby directed to place stop signs at the northerly and southernly points of the intersection of Pocahontas Drive and Coldbrook Road as described herein.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Department of Public Works and the Chief of the Police Department.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
