A RESOLUTION IN REGARDS TO AUTHORIZING THE STOP SIGNS ON INMAN AVENUE WHERE IT INTERSECTS WITH PARKWAY DRIVE

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council that dangerous situations exist on Inman Avenue at the intersection of Parkway Drive; and

WHEREAS, a traffic survey was conducted by Officer Thomas Greene of the Warwick Police Department which recommended that the stop signs on Inman Avenue at the intersection with Parkway Drive that were authorized by the Warwick Board of Public Safety on 8/22/1972 be approved by the Warwick City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by virtue of the authority of Chapter 76, Article 1, Section 76-13 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warwick, may determine that certain traffic signs are required for the protection of the public safety.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Warwick City Council hereby authorizes the stop signs on Inman Avenue where it intersects with Parkway Drive.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Department of Public Works and the Chief of the Police Department.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
