**RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO REPLACING SIGNS ON INMAN AVENUE TO
ESTABLISH A UNIFORM SPEED LIMIT OF 25 MPH**

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council that conditions exist on Reed Street, a residential district, that create contradictory speed limits on the same roadway; and

WHEREAS, a traffic survey was conducted by Officer Thomas Greene of the Warwick Police Department which recommended that the 20 MPH speed limit signs for southbound travel on Inman Avenue be replaced with 25 MPH speed limit signs to be consistent with the signs for northbound travel; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by virtue of the authority of Chapter 76 Article I Section 76-13 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warwick, may determine that certain traffic signs are required for the protection of the public safety.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of the Department of Public Works is hereby directed to replace the 20 MPH speed limit signs for southbound travel on Inman Avenue with 25 MPH speed limit signs.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Department of Public Works and the Chief of the Police Department.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
