| 18 | WHEREAS, the Bayside Wastewater Collection System, otherwise known as the |
| 19 | "Bayside Sewer Project," is a project that will involve the installation of approximately twelve |
| 20 21 | (12) miles of sewer main to service nearly 900 properties within the City of Warwick; and |
| 22 | WHEREAS, said project has been repeatedly delayed due to several issues, including but |
| 23 | not limited to structural concerns of the Mill Creek Bridge and the discovery of the remains of a |
| 24 | significant Native American village; and |
| 25 | |
| 26 | WHEREAS, although the Bayside Sewer Project has been re-prioritized in the last five |
| 27 | (5) years, the residents of these 900 properties have been waiting approximately twenty-five (25) |
| 28 | years for the installation of new sewers; and |
| 29 | |
| 30 | WHEREAS, the roads surrounding and leading to these 900 properties are in dire need of |
| 31 | resurfacing, but have not been resurfaced because of the delay to the sewer installation; and |
| 32 | WHEREAS, the residents of these 900 properties are currently connected to aging and |
| 33 34 | outdated sceptic systems and cesspools; and |
| 35 | outdated sceptic systems and cesspoors, and |
| 36 | WHEREAS, the residents connected to sceptic systems and cesspools are forced to pump |
| 37 | their sceptic tanks and cesspools on a bi-monthly basis, at their own expense; and |

| 39 | WHEREAS, the costs of these pumping services have increased greatly over the past |
| 40 | twenty-five (25) years; and |
| 41 | |
| 42 | WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Rhode Island Department of Environmental |
| 43 | Management ("DEM") that outdated sceptic tanks and cesspools be promptly removed due to |
| 44 | environmental concerns (a/k/a "Cesspool Phaseout"), but DEM has repeatedly extended an |
| 45 | amnesty period to these residents while they await the action of the Warwick Sewer Authority; |

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| 2 3 | WHEREAS, said amnesty from the DEM is set to expire in the coming months, and upon expiration, the residents of these 900 properties would incur even further penalties at their own |
| 4 | expense; and |

| 6 | WHEREAS, in February of this year, the Warwick Sewer Authority has requested bids |
| 7 | and selected the lowest qualified bidder, D'Ambra Construction, but a contract has not yet been |
| 8 | executed between the parties, and therefore, work has yet to begin on this long overdue project. |

| 10 | NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Warwick City Council hereby |
| 11 | requests that a contract be executed with D'Ambra Construction immediately so that work on |
| 12 | this project may begin forthwith, so as to spare the residents of the affected properties the further |
| 13 | expense of pumping their sceptic tanks and cesspools. |
