1	WHEREAS, adaptation projects will reduce the vulnerability of low-lying infrastructure
2	through measures that include removal, relocation, and redesign of infrastructure, re-grading of
3	banks and re-vegetation, acquisition of that area of land necessary to maintain public access, and
4	preserving or securing lateral access along the shoreline; and
5	
6	WHEREAS, reducing the vulnerability of our infrastructure is vital to the economic
7	prosperity and quality of life of the citizens of the state; and
8	
9	WHEREAS, the State of Rhode Island and its cities and towns need assistance in
10	addressing the impacts of climate change including removing and relocating vulnerable
11	infrastructure.
12	
13	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Warwick supports
14	passage of the House Bill 5628 and Senate Bill 412, Ocean State Climate Adaptation and
15	Resilience Fund (OSCAR) legislation by the RI General Assembly.
16	
17	The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Senators and
18	Representatives from the City of Warwick.
19	
20	This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
