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2	Resolved that,
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4 5	WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and
6	WHEREAS, in the performance of our duties as Warwick City Council members, it is
7	critical to be fully prepared to analyze the annual budget as well as all fiscal questions and
8 9	issues that come before this esteemed body for consideration and a vote; and
10	WHEREAS, The Rhode Island Division of Municipal Finance provides guidance,
11	information and education to municipalities in achieving and maintaining fiscal stability and in
12	complying with state law but will only monitor corrective action, when warranted; and
13	
14	WHEREAS, in addition to the annual actuarial briefing presented to the Warwick City
15	Council, a comprehensive audit should be conducted prior to the fourth quarter of FY16 and
16	before our receipt of the Annual Budget.

18	NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Warwick City Council hereby requests
19	a comprehensive audit be conducted by an outside company of all City of Warwick financial
20	responsibilities, including the Purchasing function. Said audit should compare City of Warwick
21	financial procedures with established "Best Practices," will identify any gaps between current
22	procedures and "Best Practices" and will recommend a course of corrective action to establish
23	better financial practices in the City if such are necessary.
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25	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this comprehensive audit shall be arranged through
26	a standard competitive bid process for vendors authorized to conduct business in the State of
27	Rhode Island and experienced in conducting municipal audits including identification of current city financial procedures and any discrepancies with established "Best Practices" and
28	experienced in making recommendations for corrective action.
