**RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE CITY’S SENIOR TRANSPORTATION BUSES  
PROVIDE RIDES TO THE WALMART AT NO ADDITIONAL CHARGE**

**Resolved that,**

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City’s senior transportation busses provide rides to city seniors to supermarkets and other stores for a nominal charge; and

WHEREAS, many seniors are living on fixed incomes which causes them to shop at stores that have lower prices; and

WHEREAS, for seniors living in the southern part of the City, an economical shopping location is the Walmart located a short distance outside the City; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council that the City’s senior transportation charges an additional fee to drive seniors to the Walmart that is located a short distance outside the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council hereby requests that the City’s senior transportation busses provides to seniors to the Walmart located a short distance outside the City for the same nominal fee paid by seniors who are transported to other shopping locations within the City.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to Senior Transportation Manager.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
