**RESOLUTION IN REGARDS TO ERECTING A STOP SIGN AT THE NORTHWEST  
PORTION OF HORSENECK ROAD AND PINEHURST AVENUE**

**Resolved that,**

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, in response to resident concerns, a traffic study was conducted by the Warwick Police Department on September 19, 2020 in the area of Horseneck Road where it intersects with Pinehurst Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the traffic study revealed that there was a motor vehicle accident at this location in 2015, but that no accidents had occurred within the last five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, the traffic study also indicated that the view of oncoming eastbound traffic to operators traveling southbound on Horseneck Road is obstructed by a fence, trees and home; and

WHEREAS, the ultimate conclusion of the traffic study was that a stop sign be placed at the northwest portion of the Horseneck Road and Pinehurst Avenue intersection.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby requests that the aforementioned signs be placed in the areas recommended by the traffic study.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Department of Public Works, the Finance Director, and the Mayor.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
