**RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO PLACING STOP SIGNS ON
GERTRUDE AVENUE AT STEPHENS AVENUE, ON GREENLAWN AVENUE
AT STEPHENS AVENUE AND COLE AVENUE, ON GRAYMORE AVENUE AT
STEPHENS AVENUE AND AT COLE AVENUE AND GRAYMORE AVENUE
AND TO REMOVE SOME STOP SIGNS IN THE AREA**

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council that a very dangerous situation exists at the following intersections:

- Gertrude Avenue and Stephens Avenue,
- Greenlawn Avenue at Stephens Avenue and Cole Avenue,
- Graymore Avenue and Stephens Avenue, and
- Cole Avenue at Graymore Avenue; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council that conditions at the following intersections warrant removal of the existing stop signs:

- Stephens Avenue and Groveland Avenue,
- Gertrude Avenue at Smith Street, and
- Gertrude Avenue at Plain Street; and

WHEREAS, a traffic survey was conducted by the Police Department which recommended that the aforementioned stops signs be erected or removed; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by virtue of the authority of Chapter 76 Article 1 Section 76-13 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warwick, may determine that certain traffic signs are required for the protection of the public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Director of Public Works is hereby directed to erect the following stops signs:

- Four way stop signs at the intersection of Gertrude Avenue and Stephens Avenue,
- Stop signs on Greenlawn Avenue at the intersection of Stephens Avenue,
- Stop signs on Greenlawn Avenue at the intersection of Cole Avenue,

1 Stop signs on Graymore Avenue at the intersection of Stephens Avenue, and
2 Relocate the current stop signs on Cole Avenue at Graymore Avenue to the Graymore
3 side of the intersection; and

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following stop signs should be removed as they
6 are no longer necessary:

7 Stephens Avenue and Groveland Avenue,
8 Gertrude Avenue at Smith Street, and
9 Gertrude Avenue at Plain Street.

11 The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of
12 Public Works and the Chief of the Police Department.
