A RESOLUTION IN REGARDS TO ERECTING STOP SIGNS ON SALIX STREET,
LIMESTONE STREET, AND LANGLEY STREET WHERE THEY EACH INTERSECT
WITH HORSE NECK ROAD

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council that dangerous situations exist at the intersections of Horse Neck Road and Salix Street, Limestone Street, and Langley Street; and

WHEREAS, a traffic survey was conducted by Officer Michael Isherwood of the Warwick Police Department which recommended that stop signs be placed on Salix Street, Limestone Street, and Langley Street where they each intersect with Horse Neck Road; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by virtue of the authority of Chapter 76, Article 1, Section 76-13 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warwick, may determine that certain traffic signs are required for the protection of the public safety.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of Public Works is hereby directed to place stop signs on Salix Street, Limestone Street, and Langley Street where they each intersect with Horse Neck Road.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Department of Public Works and the Chief of the Police Department.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
