16	EXPIRING IN 2027, AND FOR ELECTIVE TERMS BEGINNING IN 2027
17	TO BE ELECTED TO FOUR YEAR TERMS WITH ONE MEMBER
18	FROM EACH OF THE CITY'S NINE WARDS

20	Resolved that,

22	WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters
23	of paramount importance to the City Council; and
24	
25	WHEREAS, Article XIII, § 8 of the Rhode Island Constitution allows for the legislative body
26	of any city or town to propose amendments to that city or town's charter, which said proposed
27	amendments shall be submitted for approval in the same manner as provided for the adoption of a
28	charter; and

30	WHEREAS, Article X, Section 10-29 of the Charter of the City of Warwick provides that all
31	amendments to the Charter be submitted to the voters of the City for approval thereof at a general or
32	special election and said amendments shall not become effective unless a majority of the persons voting upon said question shall approve said amendment or amendments; and
33 34	voting upon said question shall approve said amendment of amendments, and
35	WHEREAS, upon the approval of the General Assembly, the qualified electors of the City of
36	Warwick shall have the opportunity to vote to ratify the proposed amendments at the 2022 general
37	elections; and

39	WHEREAS, the City of Warwick may be better served by expanding the composition of the
40	school committee by incorporating more voices and perspectives in the decision-making process, and
41	by transitioning its membership to align representation to come from each of the nine wards; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Warwick City Council to propose amendments to the

Warwick City Charter to expand the composition of the School Committee in 2025 from 5 to 9

members with all terms expiring in 2027, and for elective terms beginning in 2027 to be elected to

four-year terms with one member from each of the City's nine wards, so Warwick voters can decide 1 whether to adopt these amendments. 2 3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Warwick City Council requests the General 4 Assembly approve the following amendments to the Warwick City charter: 5 6 7 For elective terms commencing January, 2025, 8 9 The School Committee shall consist of three members serving at-large to be elected for a two-year term at the 2024 general election, one district member from each of the 10 three school committee election districts to be elected for a two-year term at the 2024 11 general election, and one district member from each of the three school committee 12 election districts elected to a four-year term at the 2022 general election. 13 14 For elective terms commencing January, 2027, 15 16 The School Committee shall consist of nine members, who shall be elected at the 17 general election in 2026, and every four years thereafter, for a term of four years. One 18 member of the School Committee shall be elected from each of the nine wards, and 19 members shall be residents of the wards they represent. Service on the School 20 Committee shall be limited to three consecutive four-year terms, exclusive of service 21 prior to January, 2027 and any partial term of less than two years previously served. 22 23 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that questions appearing on the 2022 ballot shall read as follows: 25 26 27 1.
