31	WHEREAS your the engroued of the Conegol Assembly, the qualified electors of the City of
32	WHEREAS, upon the approval of the General Assembly, the qualified electors of the City of Warwick shall have the opportunity to vote to ratify the proposed amendments at the 2022 general
