RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO PLACING A STOP SIGN ON
NORTH MARLBOROUGH STREET AT LADD STREET

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council that a very dangerous situation exists at the intersection of North Marlborough Street and Ladd Street where there are three stop signs but no stop sign for traffic traveling southerly on North Marlborough Street; and

WHEREAS, a traffic survey was conducted by the Police Department which recommended that a fourth stop sign be erected on North Marlborough Street at the intersection of Ladd Street to control the traffic traveling southerly on North Marlborough Street; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by virtue of the authority of Chapter 76 Article 1 Section 76-13 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warwick, may determine that certain traffic signs are required for the protection of the public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Director of Public Works is hereby directed to erect a fourth stop sign on North Marlborough Street at the intersection of Ladd Street to control the traffic traveling southerly on North Marlborough Street.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of Public Works and the Chief of the Police Department.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
