RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO SIGNS ON WILLIAMS STREET AND LADD STREET  
TO REDUCE THE SPEED LIMIT FROM 15 MPH TO 25 MPH

Resolved that,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council that conditions exist on Williams Street and Ladd Street that warrant reducing the speed limit to 20 MPH; and

WHEREAS, a traffic survey was conducted by the Police Department which recommended that the aforementioned reduction in speed limit be implemented and that signs indicating that reduction in speed limit be posted; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by virtue of the authority of Chapter 76 Article 1 Section 76-13 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warwick, may determine that traffic signs are required for the protection of the public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Director of Public Works is hereby directed to erect the speed limit signs on Williams Street and Ladd Street that reduce the posted speed limit to 20 MPH.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of Public Works and the Chief of the Police Department.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
