On 6/6/22, I Officer Boardman, of the Warwick Police Traffic Division was assigned a Traffic Survey at the intersecting streets of Goodrich Ave and Pettigrew Dr for the specific need for a new stop sign.

On 6/22/22, I responded to the area of Goodrich Ave and Pettigrew Dr to conduct a traffic survey. I spoke with the resident at 116 Goodrich Ave, which is at the corner of Goodrich Ave and Pettigrew Dr. Mr. Paul Kennedy (DOB:6/18/54) stated he believed it was a great idea to have a stop sign put up at this intersection as Pettigrew Dr is a right of way street and main cut through street between George Arden Ave and Greeley Ave. He stated that most of the issues are at nighttime and it is people speeding on Goodrich Ave as they turn either right or left onto Pettigrew Dr without coming to a complete or even implied stop.

There is also a large blind spot on the corner of Pettigrew Dr by house #44 Pettigrew Dr which is in close proximity of the intersection of Goodrich Ave. I also spoke with the resident of 79 Pettigrew Dr, Steven Myers (DOB:12/9/62) whom has two grandchildren who often visit and play in the yard, one of them being a 6 year old boy who is deaf. He stated that cars often speed and come off of Goodrich Ave onto Pettigrew Dr at a perceived high rate of speed.

Based off of my training and experience and the NHTSA Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices handbook, it states that a STOP sign should be considered at an intersection that has restricted sight distance for the prevailing vehicle speeds and at an intersection of a less important road with a main road (Pettigrew Dr.) where application of the normal right of way rule might not be readily apparent. It is the recommendation of the Traffic Division that a Stop Sign be put in place on Goodrich Ave.

I also recommend the need for future traffic enforcement in the area to help deter and reduce speed being that Pettigrew Dr. is a frequently traveled public roadway that cuts through between two other main roadways (George Arden & Greeley).

Councilman McAllister was notified of my findings and recommendation.
