On 09/19/20 when I reported for duty at 1500 hrs I learned there was a request for a traffic study in regards to a stop sign being placed on Horseneck Rd and Pinehurst Ave. Pinehurst is a secondary street with two way traffic and a prima facie speed limit of 25 MPH. It is densely populated and runs eastbound from Oakland Beach Ave. to Seaview Dr. Horseneck Rd. is also a densely populated secondary road with posted speed limit signs of 25 MPH. Horseneck runs southbound from West Shore Rd. and ends at Pinehurst.

On 09/20/20 I drove around the area and learned there was no stop sign anywhere at the intersection. I noticed as one faced south on Horseneck and attempted to turn left (travel west) on Pinehurst their view of oncoming eastbound traffic was impeded by the property of 45 Pinehurst (there is a fence, trees and a home obstructing the view). I also observed vehicles to be parked on Pinehurst in front of 59 Pinehurst (the property located to the northwest of the intersection) which also blocked the view of vehicles which traveled west on Pinehurst through the intersection.

While reviewing records of this intersection, I learned there was an accident at 8/21/15; no other accidents in the past five years.

At approximately 2040 hrs I spoke with Councilwoman Travis who informed me she and the residents wished for a stop sign to be placed at the northwest portion of the intersection on Horseneck to stop traffic attempting to turn right or left onto Pinehurst. She said many of the residents have been complaining of "close calls" from vehicles not yielding the right of way.

It is my recommendation a stop sign be placed at the northwest portion of the Horseneck and Pinehurst intersection forcing southbound traffic on Horseneck to stop.
