Officer Chianese of the Warwick Police Department Traffic Division was assigned a traffic survey for Oak Grove Street at the end of the intersection, which is a north/south roadway that is roughly 30 feet wide. The complaint stated that there is a persistent issue with sanitation not being able to properly remove a dumpster located at the end of Oak Grove Street due to cars being parked on the westbound side of the street.

Officer Chianese responded on the scene and was able to obtain measurements from the garbage collection area where the opening was 20 feet wide and the street in that vicinity was 30 feet wide. Upon surveying the area, there is a one large condo complex, Greenwich Cove Apartments, 60-68 Oak Grove Street, has roughly six units with very limited parking and the overflow parking ends up on Oak Grove Street outside of the condo property. At 40 Oak Grove Street there is a larger condo complex where it appears there is ample parking for the residents and guest with the overflow available on Oak Grove Street.

In light of the parking issues and the limited space, as well as the necessity of trash removal for the condo complexes, it is recommended that there be a no parking on Thursdays sign placed from the Greenwich Cove Condo sign 70 feet down Oak Grove Street to allow for the sanitation vehicles to come in and navigate the dumpsters, as well as be able to safely pull in and out without any undue stress of an accident in the vicinity and/or being blocked by vehicles on the roadway. At this time, the recommendation will be submitted forward. No further actions by this officer.
