#### **Biohazard Remediation**

Unfortunately, due to the overwhelming increase in cost of PPE and supplies, Trauma Services must adjust the cost of our facility cleaning services. As always, we strive to provide you with the same quality service in a timely manner, as we have done over the years. We look forward to working with you and your communities throughout all of these current changes.

Emergency calls can be requested 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The technician/s will respond within roughly 90 minutes. If the responding technician/s will be over the 90-minute ETA, they will call with updates on the response time. When there is a high volume of calls, multiple technicians will be responding to all calls accordingly.

#### SCOPE OF SERVICE:

- All work areas will be disinfected prior to work performed with a hospital grade disinfectant.
- All areas will be broom swept or Hepa-vacuumed to remove debris.
- The structure of the designated work area will be cleaned accordingly with the proper procedures for each situation at hand. These situations include but are not limited to: Blood, feces, biological matter, HIV, Covid-19, MRSA, scabies, bedbugs, sewage, fire extinguisher dust, fentanyl/unknown powder narcotics.
- All debris generated though out this process will be contained to a Bio-Hazard waste container and disposed of properly.

#### **CERTIFIED PROFESSIONALS**

The crew will wear protection suits with respiratory gear at each response. All responding crew members are certified Bio-Hazard technicians. All hazardous material generated will be disposed of properly.
