citizens for recreation, grocery or retail shopping, or to and from the Senior Center or meal sites. This is a part time position, generally assigned to work 19

hours per week.

Duties include:

• Operates 12 or 16 passenger para-transit buses for transportation system which services senior citizen and disabled population.

- Works closely with Transportation Planner to learn schedule and routes and meets on a daily basis for route assignments and special runs.
- Provides assistance to colleagues in the Division of Senior Services as needed.
- Cleans and provides routine service of a non-mechanical nature to passenger transport vehicles on a regular basis.
