Statement of Duties: Ensures that all mechanical and electrical equipment at the wastewater treatment plant and sewage pumping stations is functional and properly maintained. Performs all necessary repairs and preventative maintenance on all equipment and structures associated with the treatment plants and pumping stations including all collection system maintenance activities. Duties include:

- Performing more complex troubleshooting and repair work that is above the ability of a Mechanic I.
- Completing all work orders pertaining to preventative maintenance.
- Checking the condition of all operating equipment and reporting to the supervisor any equipment that needs follow up attention.
- Familiarizing oneself with all facets of the operation of the wastewater treatment facility.
- Performing as an operator when necessary.
- Performing related work as required.

Education & Experience: Graduation from a standard high school or vocational school, including or supplemented by courses of mechanical or electrical nature; experience sufficient to ensure proficiency in the repair of gasoline and diesel engines and electrical motors and in the welding of metal parts for various kinds of machinery; or any equivalent combination of education and experience.

Special Requirement: Applicants must possess **or must obtain** a valid State of Rhode Island Commercial Driver's License (CDL) **within 1 year of employment**. Must also possess or obtain a State of Rhode Island Grade I Wastewater Operator License **within one year of employment**. All applicants will be subject to a driver's license check for the last two years and a criminal background check. Negative finds may prevent applicants from being considered.
