## **Overall Progress Narrative:**

The Office of Housing & Community Development continues to work on two (2) projects associated with reducing the impacts of future flooding:

- 1) Buckey Brook/Warwick Pond drainage restoration. The Office working through the City of Warwick's Department of Public Wroks have applied for the permitting associated with the restoration of normal drainage of Warwick Pond into Buckeye Brook. Due to regulatory review for a fresh water wetlands alteration permit that has taken longer than anticipated, the timeframe of the work completion has been extedned. Due to the nature of the work, removal of fragmities, the work can only be accomplished in the early to mid fall season. The Office continues to work with the RI Department of Environmental Management to address their concerns regarding the proposed scope of work. It is anticipated that the wetlands alteraction permit will be apporved in mid to late winter, with bidding for a contractor to perform the work will occur shorlty there after.
- 2) Flood Hardening of Warwick Sewer Pumping Stations. Work continues on the flood hardening on 3 Warwick Sewer Authority Pumping stations that were severly impacted during the 2010 flooding events. Work at 2 of the stations are substantially complete, with the remaining work to be coordinated once National Grid relocates the power feed to the stations. Due to height restrictions for the electric service, one of the stations needs a new utility pole installed. Work at the third stations was substantially completed on December 31, 2018.

#### **Activity Description:**

Fundsd will be used to make repair and or improvements to public facilities and infrastructure damaged in the March 2010 floods.

Funds will be used to flood harden 3 Warwick Sewer Authority pumping stations that were heavily damaged due to flooding. The pumping stations, located in and serving predominately low/mod income neighborhoods, will be hardened to minimize the impact of future storm damage due to flooding. The RFP for flood hardening of the pumping stations is currently out for bid and it is expected that the work will begin immediately upon award of contract.

In addition, funds will also be used to restore the natural flow of Buckeye Brook in the area of Lakeshore Drive and Warwick Pond. Vegitation has overgrown and clogged the natural drainage of Warwick Pond and the flow of Buckeye Brook causing persistant flooding of Lakeshore Drive. The RFP for environmental services is currenlty being prepared and will be awarded in the Spring with work commencing shortly thereafter.
