#### **Activity Description:**

Fundsd will be used to make repair and or improvements to public facilities and infrastructure damaged in the March 2010 floods.

Funds will be used to flood harden 3 Warwick Sewer Authority pumping stations that were heavily damaged due to flooding. The pumping stations, located in and serving predominately low/mod income neighborhoods, will be hardened to minimize the impact of future storm damage due to flooding. The RFP for flood hardening of the pumping stations is currently out for bid and it is expected that the work will begin immediatety upon award of contract.

In addition, funds will also be used to restore the natuaral flow of Buckeye Brook in the area of Lakeshore Drive and Warwick Pond. Vegitation has overgrown and clogged the natural drainage of Warwick Pond and the flow of Buckeye Brook causing persistant flooding of Lakeshore Drive. The RFP for environmental services is currently being prepared and will be awarded in the Spring with work commencing shortly thereafter.
