<u>Statement of Duties</u>: Works under the general supervision of the Automotive Chief, and welds, fabricates and repairs the full range of vehicles and equipment used by City departments.

Duties include:

- Performs skilled welding and repairs and fabrication on vehicles and equipment.
- Operates various types of welding equipment including Mig, Tig and Arc welders, plasma cutters and oxygen and acetylene torches.
- Isolates and disconnects 12 volt systems to ensure on board systems are not impacted by welding operations.
- Estimates time and material for the purpose of determining cost of a specific job.
- Maintains equipment, tools and supplies to ensure availability and function including steel inventory and welding consumables.
- Mends damaged body and fenders by hammering out or filling in dents and welding broken parts.
- Squares up and welds various geometries of components.
- Understands various weld symbols on blue prints.
- Performs basic maintenance or repairs to vehicles, or assists mechanics with same.
- Welds both vertical and horizontal plane geometry.
- Understands various edge preps before welding.
- · Performs other related duties as needed.

Education & Experience: Graduation from a vocational or trade school with a specialty in welding, vehicle repair or related, and a minimum of five years of experience in welding and fabricating; or a combination of substantially equivalent education and experience.
