
Mr. Joseph Boisvert: Yeah, we're all going to be up in the parking lot. I had spoken with Mr. Matteson, Mike Matteson, and he sent me over some stuff as to where the trucks are going to be. I was hoping to get him over there so that he can show me all of the entrances, fire hydrants, all that stuff so that I can make sure the trucks are where they need to be for his inspection.

Chairwoman Baxter: Okay, all right. Does anybody have any other questions about this?

Clerk McGovern: How many vehicles do you have?

Mr. Boisvert: We're probably going to start with eight or so. But, I mean, I think that the lot can handle 12-15 eventually. We're looking to do this every Thursday throughout the summer. All of the trucks are donating ten percent of their sales to the imPOSSIBLE Dream. So, nobody's making money off of this event. There's no middle man that's taking this money, there's no fee for the trucks to be there. This event is to make money for the imPOSSIBLE Dream and local vendors.
